Friends of the Van Duzen Proposal for Environmental Education at Loleta Elementary in grades preK-8th

#### **Nurturing Nature : Overview**

For the past 15 years, FOVDR has been monitoring the Van Duzen Watershed for water quality and salmon. Working with other fellow scientists, FOVDR has taught extensively in elementary schools in the Eel River Valley and at Fortuna Union High School. The two goals of the FOVDR are to train the next generation of young scientists and to preserve the salmon run. We are actively involved in both missions.

As the director of FOVDR and as a teacher, administrator, and environmentalist in Humboldt County for the past 42 years, I have developed extensive curriculum for the classroom and for working in the field. We have been active in field trips to the Sequoia Zoo, the Scotia Aquarium, Grizzly Creek Redwoods Park, Pamplin Grove, the Van Duzen Watershed Protection Zone, the Eel River from Fortuna to Ferndale, the Wildlife Sanctuary in Loleta, and exploring the incredible beauty of our local community.

Our goal in the Nurturing Nature Loleta is to share this extensive curriculum with students in grades preK-8. An important component to learning is to incorporate art, poetry, and writing to gain a better understanding of our environment. FOVDR, along with California Poet in the Schools Dan Levinson have produced two books of poetry/prose entitled the Van Duzen Voice in 2014 and Eel River Expressions in 2019. One of our FOVDR members, Barbara Domanchuk, is very active in the environmental community and is a proponent of combining art and nature. She has coined the term Ecology and the Arts and it is an important element for Nurturing Nature.



Recent studies of children going out in Nature show evidence that engaging in outdoor activities as a youth is an important component to achieving happiness as an adult!!!

Our major points of emphasis will be the following: December : Planning and giving intro lessons preK-6th January : Water, Salmon, protecting Planet Earth February : Habitat, Watersheds, Biology and Botany March : Birds and Plants and Trees April : Trillium, Bird Drawings (Possible workshop by Gus Clarke, phenomenal local artist) May : Water Monitoring Grades 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, Salmon Release 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>, Creek Days at CR June : Final Wrap Up

## **IMPLEMENTATION:**

Classes and field trips will be conducted on **designated alternative** Mondays and Fridays with 2-3 classes for each day beginning with Grades preK-4 starting on Monday Jan. 9<sup>th</sup> and grades 5-8 starting on January 13<sup>th</sup>.

Classes will consist of Environmental lessons adding art, poetry, and videos about Nature. There will also be guest lecturers and artists.

Field trips will be mostly on Fridays except for the Birds at the Wildlife Sanctuary in March and the Trillium season in early April where field trips may be on both days to get all classes to the Van Duzen River leaving from my home in Carlotta.

For the upper grades we will investigate the annual Creek Days Events at College of the Redwoods in May.
